Leo Arcand is a Woodland Cree sculptor from the Alexander First Nations reserve in Northern Alberta. Leo sketched since he was a young boy, but for over 20 years his medium of choice has been stone carving.

Arcand works mainly in soapstone, drawing his inspiration from a deep spirituality and keen belief that there must be a balance in all things.

Leo's deep spirituality, a reflection of his people's natural affinity with Mother Earth are some of the themes that come through in his work which combine both a sense of power and peace.
